Next move:

- DGF structure, roles & responsibilities.

- How to apply a HRBA in programming.

Cont'd



- How to develop a ToC for your organization.
- How to apply and possibly, when and how to bring on board learning and PDIA approach to programming.
- How to design a results framework for your organization.
- How to identify and bring on board collaboration with other IP, and highlight the same in the proposal.

Start working on your proposals



- Put together the narrative;
- Develop narrative, expected RF, including contribution to DGF RF;
- Develop a work plan; and activity-based budget (zero-based);
- Share draft framework and proposed budget for quick comments with DGF;
- Consider other relevant issues and seek support from your PM;
- Draft narrative proposal, together with a results framework, work plan and budget will be reviewed by DGF and work with you towards finalization;
- Once approved, then move to signing a partnership agreement and funding

Timelines



- We expect that from here, you all embark on pulling together your proposals in line with the grant application format.
- Please apply all considerations shared with you during the 3 days' workshop.
- Previous IPs will have a 3 months (Jan – Mar 2018) exit grant to enable a close out of the DGF 1+ project. You should work on and finalize the proposals for second phase of DGF and have it approved within this period.
- New IPs should also expedite and have proposal ready as soon as possible.
- We expect that more complex proposals might require more time, though.
- Overall, the first three to six months of 2018 we should have the proposals finalized and approved for funding.
