Why Result Framework



The RF shows how the achievement of lower level results **(outputs)** leads to the achievement of the higher level results **(outcomes/objectives)**, ultimately resulting in the **impact/goal**.



Its a development hypothesis or a theory
about how **intended**
change/Result will occur.

IP Result frame work



- Need to be aligned to DGF but not identical
- Needs to be consultative within IPs staff and the DGF.
- Aligned with IP interventions/Design
- IP may use a variety of approaches to develop their respective results frameworks **BUT** must be in the same format- **DGF** to provide the format

DGF does not directly
implement
interventions- IP
Projects contribute to
DGF program.

Why Align IP with DGF RF



- ❑ Accountability
- ❑ Joint learning
- ❑ Need to harmonize efforts/Achievements of all the IPs
- ❑ IP are part of the big picture- Contribution to the big picture

How to align?



1. Understand DGF program design- Sphere, AoI, Results Vs IP Program design etc.
2. Same formats (RF, etc)
3. Performance Indicators

A measure(s)

that describe how program is

achieving

its

intended results.

“Results statement”

identifies what to accomplish

“Indicators”

specifies what to measure (Number, Freq & %age)

a) DGF Indicators:

- 10 High level Indicators- Country level data)
- 12 Intermediate indicators- (*Direct IP contribution*)
- 19 Out put Indicators (*6-Process, 5-Beneficiary Indicators, 8- Other Out puts.*)

b) IP Indicators:

DGF Standard Indicators

as they are, **no alteration at all**
even numbering

IP Custom indicators

(SMART)

Baseline

and

Targets

How DGF plans to measure these Indicators- DGF Level?



- High level outcome Indicators– *To be tracked from secondary sources*
- Intermediate Outcome Indicators– *(Survey, thematic studies e.g Outcome mapping, Impact tracing etc)*
- Out put Indicators (IP *Routine data collection*)
